Donald Lee Stierley, 83, of Poseyville, Indiana, born to Arthur A. Stierley, Sr. and Mary L. (Rivers) Stierley on March 20, 1937, in Blairsville, Indiana, passed away Saturday, December 12, 2020, at Park Terrace Village in Evansville, Indiana.

He attended Blairsville Elementary and Wadesville High School. After school, Don trucked coal and hauled grain for farmers, then worked at Faultless Caster in Evansville, Indiana for 44 years until retirement in 1998. He was an honorably discharged veteran serving in the United States Army and a member of the Poseyville American Legion, the Tri-State Sam's Camping Club and former member of the Wadesville Christian Church. His hobbies included boating, fishing, camping and eating out with friends.

Surviving are his daughters: Pamela, Kim, Susie, Sheryl, Pattie and Lisa; brothers: Harold Gene Stierley (Susie) and Arthur Stierley, Jr. (Betty Ann); several grandchildren and great grandchildren and nieces, nephews and cousins.
