Doris E. Butler, 85, of Poseyville, Indiana born to Homer and Opal (Nicholson) Butler on April 18, 1929, in Poseyville, Indiana, passed away Tuesday, June 3, 2014, at Deaconess Hospital in Evansville, Indiana.

He served in the military with the US Navy during the Korean War. He had worked for Earl Erbacher Electric, Mott Wade Construction and was Superintendent of the Poseyville Municipal Utilities for 25 years. He was the Sexton of the Poseyville Cemetery and served on the cemetery board for many years and after retirement, he devoted his time to his family. He was a 50 year member of the Poseyville Masonic Lodge; 60 year member and Adjutant of the Poseyville American Legion and the Wadesville Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Surviving are his wife: G. Maxine (Turner) Butler; 4 sons: Roger (Judy) Butler of Mt. Vernon, Indiana, Kerry Butler of Mt.
