Edward Lee Rueger 84 of Mount Juliet, Tennessee and formerly of New Harmony, peacefully passed out of this life on July 22, 2023. Ed was born December 6, 1938, to Malcolm Edward and Esther (Oeth) Rueger in Mount Vernon Indiana. He was preceded death by his parents and son: Jon Edward Rueger.

He attended Mount Vernon, Indiana schools and graduated in 1957. Ed played football with the 1954 undefeated PAC champions and was inducted into the Mount Vernon Athletic Hall of Fame in 1989.

Ed was a member of the Indiana National Guard for two years before joining the US army in 1958. He was stationed in Germany serving as a tank commander patrolling the East German border.

Settling in New Harmony, Indiana in 1963, Ed worked at Babcock and Wilcox in Mount Vernon as a welding inspector. Ed was a member of the New Harmony Volunteer Fire Department and First Baptist Church of New Harmony serving as deacon, music director, Sunday school teacher of 3- & 4-year-olds and bus driver.

He was an auctioneer, owning an auction barn in Mount Vernon.

Ed and his family relocated to South Florida in 1979 where he became an entrepreneur, an occupation he loved and would continue in for the rest of his

life. Moving to Mount Juliet, Tennessee he founded his company, E&S sales; buying and selling in several markets, including Nashville, Knoxville, Louisville, Evansville, and Lebanon, Tennessee.

Ed was a positive, cheerful person who never met a stranger. He had a ready smile, a giving heart, and praised the lord for each day on earth. Ed is survived by his wife of 65 years: Shari (Taylor) Rueger; sons: Jeffrey of Old Hickory, TN and Rick of Pembroke Pines, FL; sister: Dorothy Rueger of Mount Vernon, IN; granddaughter: Lindsey Rueger (Josh McMahan) of Donelson, TN; granddaughter: Erica Rueger-Quinones (Adam) of Plantation FL; grandson: Will Rueger (Bethany) of Mt Juliet, TN; brother-in-law: Michael Taylor (Brenda) of Coconut Grove, FL; sister-in-law: Cynthia Taylor Lyke of Aurora, CO; great grandson: Ryan Gutierrez of Davie, FL; niece and nephews: Kara Peters, Ryan Lyke, Bryce Taylor, and Kevin Taylor.
