Elva Joyce Weatherholt, 80, of Wadesville, Indiana, born to Rolta Lee and Evelyn Marie (Murphy) Hedges on October 2, 1934, in Stewartsville, Indiana, passed away Thursday, February 19, 2015, at West River Health Campus in Evansville, Indiana.

Known by many as "Grandma Joyce", she graduated from Poseyville High School in 1952. After graduation she worked at Sears Roebuck in downtown Evansville, Indiana. She also worked for the Farmers Bank and Trust and then for the United States Postal Service for 23 years. While employed at the post office, Joyce enjoyed visiting several tri-state elementary schools giving presentations on stamps and stamp collecting.

She was a member of Black River General Baptist Church until 1993. She also was a member of Bible Study Fellowship in Evansville, Indiana and a 50 year member of the Golden Fleece Order of the Eastern Star Post 176. In her later years, she attended St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Poseyville, Indiana.

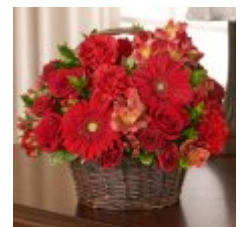
