Ernest “Ernie” William Rapp, 83, of New Harmony, Indiana, born October 8, 1941, to Earl William and Mildred V. (Cooper) Rapp in Evansville, Indiana, passed away, Friday, February 21, 2025 at his home in New Harmony, Indiana.

He graduated from New Harmony High School, Indiana University and earned his Master’s Degree at Western Kentucky University. He taught at New Harmony High School and later was a teacher, administrator and superintendent at North Posey High School. He was a United States Navy Veteran serving during the Vietnam War and a member of the VFW, American Legion and the Masonic Artic Lodge in New Harmony, Indiana. He was an Acacia fraternity member and an avid IU Sports fan. He was a cycling enthusiast and enjoyed his grandchildren’s sporting events, summers at Lake Wawasee in Syracuse, Indiana and snow birding to Ft. Myers during the winter.
