Gregory Allen “Chops” Marshall, 59, of Poseyville, Indiana, born to Jim and Dorothy (Bayer) Marshall on July 5, 1960, in Princeton, Indiana, passed away Friday, August 23, 2019, at St. Vincent Medical Center in Evansville, Indiana after a three week battle with lung cancer.

He graduated from Indiana University in 1982 and began working at Clem, Dassel & Co. as a CPA and later became a partner in the firm. He had the pleasure of assisting many people over the years. Greg was an avid golfer and IU fan. He was a member at St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church and served on the Parish Council. He was a member of Cambridge Men’s Club. President, and Treasurer over more than 20 years.

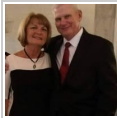

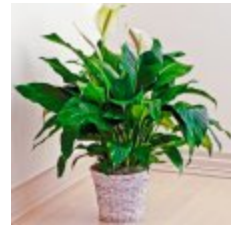

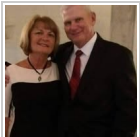
