Harold was a World War II veteran in the US Army Air Corp receiving an EAME Theater Ribbon with 5 Bronze Stars. 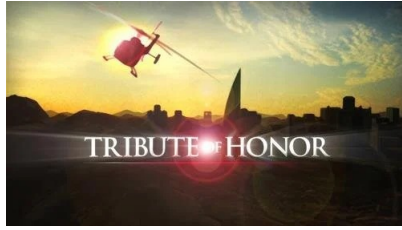
