Harold E. Schweikhart, 94, of Poseyville, Indiana, born to Edward Benjamin and Mary Ellen (Overton) Schweikhart on October 7, 1921, in Stewartsville, Indiana, passed away Saturday, April 9, 2016, at his home in Poseyville, Indiana.

He graduated from Poseyville High School in 1940 and was a WWII Veteran serving in the US Army Air Corp flying 45 missions over Europe and North Africa.

He was a member of the Poseyville Masonic Lodge, Hadi Temple, the Scottish Rite for 65 years and the Hadi Shrine White Horse Patrol for 50 years; Veterans of Foreign Wars and was Past Commander of the Poseyville American Legion. He was a Kentucky Colonel and a member of the Mt. Vernon Elks and the Poseyville Kiwanis. He was President of the MSD of North Posey Building Corp., Vice President of the Poseyville Telephone Company and owner/operator of Harold's Restaurant in Poseyville, Indiana. Surviving are his 2 daughters: Jane Gaines of Henderson, Kentucky and Sue Mabe of Princeton, Indiana; 5 grandchildren: Michael and Marc Hall, Greg and

Darren Hanks and Michelle Stone; 3 great grandchildren: Ian, Joshua, Kristian Hall; 1 great great grandchild: DeLaney Hall and a brother: Earl Schweikhart of Evansville, Indiana.

Preceding him in death were his parents; wife: Georgia (Jefferies) Schweikhart and siblings: Lural Schweikhart and Anna Mae Overton.

Funeral services will be 10 a.m., Wednesday, April 13, 2016, at the Werry Funeral Home in Poseyville, Indiana with burial in Poseyville Cemetery. Rev. John Matsel officiating.
