Jessica Anne Alexander, 28, of Evansville, Indiana, born to Bobby and Debbie (De Priest) Alexander on July 28, 1988, in Evansville, Indiana, passed away peacefully in her sleep Sunday, February 5, 2017, at her home near Evansville, Indiana.

She graduated from North Posey High School in 2007 where she participated in Spell Bowl and Academic Bowls at local and state levels. She also was active in Soccer and the Marching Viking Band playing the Saxophone. She was a member of the first North Posey Marching Band to participate in ISSMA State Finals. Jessica also participated in North Posey Musicals each year of high school. Later, she attended Ivy Tech and USI where she majored in Nursing, Ill health stood in the way of her reaching her goal of being able to assist others with their health problems. She was ill since early childhood with systemic lupus and kidney failure but she did not allow those things to get in her way. She participated in 4-H Dog Club for 10 years showing her German Shepherd, Zeus. Together, they went happily to State competition twice. She was a member of the Wadesville Christian Church where she served as a

deacon and on several committees. She compiled the theme and scripture readings for the daily devotions for the Church Chatter Newsletter. Jessica was an avid journalist and Bible student who exhibited undeniable faith and devotion. Despite her illness, Jess will always be remembered for her quit wit, smiling face and her “never give up” attitude. Her determination and desire to “keep going” will be missed by the many lives she touched during her short life.

Surviving are her parents; a brother: Wes Alexander; aunt: Shirley Fields; uncle: Mike (Jeannie) De Priest, several cousins, as well as her many dear friends.

Preceding her in death were her paternal grandparents: Forrest and Treasy Alexander; maternal grandparents: John and Mary Ellen De Priest; uncles: Danny and Mark Alexander.

Funeral services will be 10 a.m., Friday, February 10, 2017, at the Wadesville Christian Church, 7226 Highway 66, Wadesville, Indiana, with burial in Laurel Hill Cemetery in Wadesville, Indiana. Rev. Mary Hurley and Pastor Ben Brandt officiating.

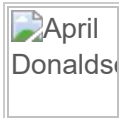
