Juanita Ann (Boyles) Goldman went to be with her savior on Saturday, February 24th at 4:30pm. She was born to Vernon Paul and Sarah Opal (Gambill) Boyles on May 5th, 1931, in Pampa, Texas. Her family relocated to Illinois in 1941. She married Percy Leo Goldman on February 14th, 1952. Juanita spent most of her life working in the housekeeping industry. She performed domestic duties in homes and businesses in Gibson and Posey Counties. She also managed the housekeeping departments at the New Harmony Inn, the Executive Inn and Deaconess School of Nursing before her retirement. She was the last surviving, founding member of The Apostolic Bible Church in Stewartsville, Indiana. She would always comment that "She loves her church".

Juanita was known for her loving heart and dedication to Christ. She spent countless hours assisting the elderly ladies from the church, as well as transporting numerous children to Sunday School. She took children and youth to church camps in Illinois and Indiana for many years and was blessed to be able to pray many of them through to the Holy Ghost, one of her fondest

memories and greatest accomplishments.
