Lina Mittino, 96, passed away on Monday, January 29, 2018 at Premier Healthcare of New Harmony, Indiana.

She was born on May 15, 1921 to Antonio and Armida (Zucchiati) Casteller in Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, Canada. She proudly became an American citizen on September 27, 1943 in Detroit, Michigan, where she resided with her husband, Louis Mittino. They married on April 27, 1940 at San Francisco Catholic Church in the Motor City. Both were employed at the Ford Motor Company at the time and she worked many other jobs in her lifetime, in sales and food service.

Lina was renowned for her cooking ability and could whip up homemade noodles and ravioli with her dexterous hands as fast as she could make savory meatballs and sauce. She was an accomplished seamstress and craftswoman, making macramé, latch-hooked rugs, crochet and needlework creations. She loved to play cards and bingo, travel to many places, playing with her dogs and cheering for her Detroit Tigers. Most of all, she loved to dance, and sometimes well into the night at parties, especially with her

husband "Louie". Always proud of her Italian heritage, she delighted the residents of the Charles Ford Home and the nursing home with her loud singing of "O Sole Mio" to them.

Lina is survived by her three children: Robert (Judy) Mittino of Allen Park, Michigan, Raymond (Judy) Mittino of Estero, Florida and Lois Mittino (Jim) Gray of Mount Vernon, Indiana. Her grandchildren are Matthew (Veronica) Mittino, Aimee Mittino, Adam (Sarah) Mittino, Michael (Katie) Gray, and Martyn (Ashley) Gray, and she has numerous great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband of almost fifty years: Louis, who died in 1991; a companion: Lucien Maes, who died in 2000, and two brothers: Aldo and Remo Casteller.

Visitation will be Thursday, February 1, 2018 from 4 to 7 p.m. at Werry Funeral Home in New Harmony, Indiana with a celebration of "A Life Well Lived" at 7 p.m.

Father Jim Sauer will officiate a mass of Christian Burial at 11 a.m. Friday, February 2, 2018 at Holy Angels Catholic Church in New Harmony, Indiana. 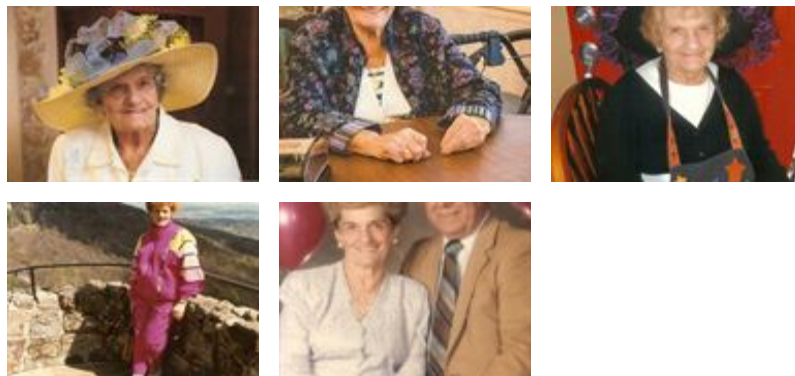
