Marybeth Wiggins 81, of Evansville, Indiana, born to Lawrence and Mary (Clements) Page on February 24, 1931, in Evansville, Indiana, while working hard to recover from injuries after a fall early in July, passed peacefully on Sunday, September 2, 2012, at Kindred Transitional Care & Rehabilitation-Angel River in Newburgh, Indiana.

She was a member of the Poseyville Christian Church and a long time board member of the Poseyville Carnegie Public Library. She graduated from Bosse High School in 1948 and graduated with undergraduate degrees from Stephens College and Evansville College. She received her master's degree from the University of Evansville. She was a teacher at Vogel, White and Stockwell schools in Evansville, Indiana. Her residences included Las Vegas, NV, Long Beach, CA, New York City, Charlotte, NC, Poseyville and Evansville, Indiana.
