Millard Roy Maier, 84, of Wadesville, Indiana, born to Millard P. and Elizabeth (Cotton) Maier on January 28, 1931, in Wadesville, Indiana, passed away Thursday, December 3, 2015, at West River Health Campus in Evansville, Indiana.

He graduated from Wadesville High School in 1949 and was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church in Poseyville, Indiana, VFW post 1114 in Evansville, Indiana, the American Angus Association.

Roy was a true cattleman; first a dairyman with his father Millard for nearly 35 years. He married Murlea Webb on May 27, 1953 then immediately reported to Camp Chaffee, Arkansas where he attended Fire Direction School. He then was stationed in South Korea for the next 16 months. The last 40 years, his focus was on raising beef cattle, his favorite being registered Angus. Making hay and traveling to cattle sales were his favorite pastimes. Roy loved seeing new places; he and his wife traveled to many countries and states.

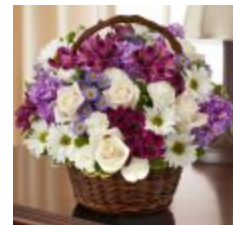
