Ora Curtis Williams, 80, of Wadesville, Indiana, passed away Wednesday, February 22, 2017 around 4 a.m. at Solarbron Healthcare Facility in Evansville, Indiana.

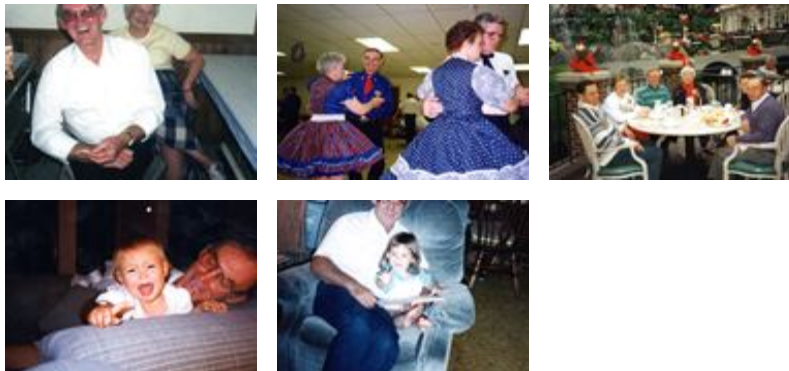
