Dr. Robert “Bob” Wayne Hammelman, 87, of Newburgh, Indiana, born to Dr. Albert William and Esther Johanna (Bobe) Hammelman on December 8, 1928, in Poseyville, Indiana, passed away Tuesday, August 30, 2016, at Deaconess VNA Charlier Hospice Center in Evansville, Indiana.

He graduated from Poseyville High School in 1946 where he was class president and captain of the basketball team; Evansville College in 1950 and Indiana University Dental School in 1954. After graduation from dental school, Bob served as a dental officer (Captain) in the United States Air Force. He was a member of the American Dental Association, the Indiana Dental Association and a 64 year member of the Poseyville Masonic Lodge. He also was a lifelong member of St. Paul’s United Methodist Church in Poseyville, Indiana. He practiced Dentistry for 47 years at Hammelman Dental Office in Poseyville, Indiana where he worked with his father and brother. He enjoyed watching Indiana Hoosiers and Evansville Aces basketball and was an avid St. Louis Cardinal fan. He enjoyed dining out, especially Thursday evenings at The House of Como. Most of all, he loved spending time with his family and

attending his grandchildren's activities.

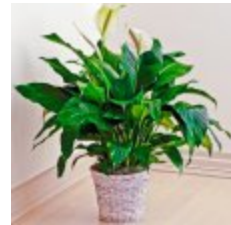
