Sharon Rae Broadhead, 89, of Poseyville, Indiana, born November 28, 1934, to Vernon and Alberta (Ludwig) Hooe in Evansville, Indiana, passed away, Friday, February 23, 2024 at Linda E. White Hospice House in Evansville, Indiana.

She was an only child. She graduated from Central High School in 1951, and in July, 1955, she married the love of her life, Walter Broadhead, a young farmer from Mt. Vernon, Indiana. She was initiated into farm life quickly when shortly after their marriage, Walter lost parts of three fingers in a corn picker accident in the Wabash River bottoms, and she drove him to the hospital in Evansville.

Walter and Sharon made their home on a farm just west of Poseyville in the Fall of 1955, and there they lived and had two children, John Broadhead (Laura) and Sherrie Maglinger (Stan). Sharon was a full-time homemaker and farm helper. It was a life that at first scared her to death but which she quickly came to embrace and love.

After her children graduated from college, Sharon returned to school and obtained a nursing degree at the University of Evansville and became a

registered nurse. Later, she obtained her realtor's license, and then her real estate broker's license, and Walter obtained his realtor's license, and together they owned and operated Broadhead Realty for a number of years.

Sharon enjoyed painting with watercolors, was a voracious reader, and she and Walter enjoyed dancing for many years.

Sharon was a member of St. Paul's Global Church in Poseyville, Indiana. Her faith in God was a central part of her life.

Sharon's greatest and most important calling was as a wife, mother, and Nana. In addition to her two children, she is survived by her six grandchildren: Jessica Hudson (Drew), Kate Maile, Anne Zuckerman (Drew), Erin Maile, Ben Broadhead (Molly) and Alex Maile (Jade) along with nine great grandchildren: Karmyn Maile, Vera O'Daniel, Livia O'Daniel, Ashley Zuckerman, Olivia Zuckerman, Caroline Zuckerman, Cameron Hudson, Hadley Hudson, and Nolan Broadhead.

Preceding her in death were her parents and husband: Walter Broadhead in June 2020.
