Susan Lee Shoaff (prev. Reynolds) passed away suddenly on May 1, 2024 in Evansville, Indiana surrounded by family, after a day spent doing one of her favorite activities: eating lunch with her husband and two of her grandchildren at The Chopstick House.

She is survived by her husband: Donald Shoaff; children: Elizabeth (Bishop) Mumford and Stephen (Jennifer) Reynolds and her five fantastic grandchildren: Cpt. Eugene Bishop Mumford, Jacob Patrick Mumford, Letitia Claire Mumford, Abigail Robinson Reynolds and Lillian Winslow Reynolds.

She was predeceased by her first husband: Irvin Clarence Reynolds; parents: James and Lillian Robinson; sisters: Evelyn Robinson Kurtzeborn, Jessie Ailene Robinson Partington, Elineor O. Robinson Yeadon and brother: James Etoile Robinson.

Born March 27, 1938 in Evansville, Indiana, she married Irvin Reynolds in 1958 and settled in New Harmony, Indiana. They were married for 58 years before his death in 2016. In 2018, Susan married Donald Shoaff in Evansville, Indiana where they resided.

Susan graduated from the University of Evansville with three BA and three MA degrees. She was a special education teacher in MSD Mt. Vernon schools for 26 years and loved her students. She continued as a substitute teacher at

several area schools for many years after she retired.

Susan was an active member of many organizations. She was a member of Alpha Sigma Alpha college sorority, Kappa Kappa Kappa in New Harmony, Indiana and education organizations were: Alpha Delta Kappa; Phi Delta Kappa; National Education Association; Indiana State Teachers Association; Order of Eastern Star and Daughters of the Nile.

One of Susan's greatest joys was her role not as a grandma but as a beloved "Memaw", taking great care in selecting gifts and creating scrapbooks for her grandchildren. Additionally, Bethel Temple became a large part of Susan's life, where she enthusiastically attended Bible Studies programs and found community in her later years. After creating and maintaining her school's website, she and Don started a web design business and continued managing websites for many years. Finally, she was a lifelong jitterbug and swing dancer, and was excited to get back into dancing again as she regained strength, as she told her family at her final meal. Now, we know that she is jitterbugging with the angels in the great dancehall in the sky.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m., Saturday, May 4, 2024 at the Werry Funeral Home in New Harmony, Indiana with committal at Stewartsville Cemetery.
