Thomas Owen Cook, 78, of Poseyville, Indiana, born to Owen and Mildred (Richards) Cook on January 14, 1938, in Evansville, Indiana, passed away Tuesday, September 6, 2016, after a decade long struggle with Progressive Supranuclear Palsy, at Hamilton Point in Newburgh, Indiana.

He graduated in 1956 from Corvallis High School in Corvallis, Oregon. He attended college at McMinnville College, Oregon; University of Buffalo and Evansville College. Tom also served his country as an Army photographer for the Army Aviation Testing at Fort Rucker, Alabama. He was owner/operator of Tom Cook Upholstery Center in Evansville, Indiana.

Surviving are his wife of 56 years: Minnie Edwina (Arnold); three sons: Mark and fiancée Penny (Shephard) Johnson, George and his companion Ginni Thompson and Jim and wife Becky (Reynolds) Cook; a sister: Beverly Mae Swearingen; a brother: Byron Lee Cook; grandchildren: John, Stephanie, Drew, Emma, Allie; several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.

Preceding him in death were his parents and brothers: Clive Michael and Robert Lynton Cook.

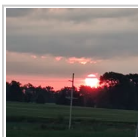
