William D. "Bill" Duncan, 93, of Griffin, Indiana, formerly of Granite City, Illinois, born January 2, 1931, to Gussie and Pauline (Blackston) Duncan in Dixon, Kentucky, passed away, Wednesday, April 17, 2024 at the Charles Ford Memorial Home in New Harmony, Indiana.

Bill was 1 of 13 children and graduated from New Harmony High School in 1949, afterwards he began his career at Air Products. He married Marilyn Daugherty on November 26, 1949 and they lived in Michigan for several years. He was a Corporal in the United States Army, serving from 1952-1954 during the Korean Conflict.

During his working career, Bill and Marilyn spent several years in Puerto Rico where he was promoted to increasing roles of responsibility and retired from Air Products after 33 years of service.

In retirement, Bill enjoyed owning and training racehorses, spending long days at the Fairmont Park Horse Racetrack near his home in Granite City, Illinois. Bill also enjoyed playing cards and golf, additionally; he was a life-long passionate fan of the St. Louis Cardinal Baseball team, watching as many games as possible in person and on TV.

Bill was a member of the American Legion in New Harmony, Indiana and the St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Poseyville, Indiana.

Surviving are his wife of almost 75 years: Marilyn L. (Daugherty) Duncan; brothers: Michael L. Duncan (Deretha) and Gus Duncan (Pat); sister: Carolyn Davis; nieces and nephews to whom he was very close: Jacqueline George, Bobbi Barritt (Allen), Ernest Daugherty (Lisa), William Daugherty (Julie) and Lisa Sanders.
