William John Kincheloe, 96, formerly of Wadesville, Indiana, born to William and Mary (Mitz) Kincheloe on July 6, 1923, in Oliver, Indiana, passed away Monday, August 26, 2019, in Evansville, Indiana.

He was a loving husband and father and graduated from Wadesville High School in 1941. He was wounded serving his country during WWII as a Tank Driver under General Patton. He retired from Bucyrus-Erie, Continental Emsco and A1 Tooling. He loved working with wood making flag cases for the soldiers that have died and belonged to the Ohio Valley Woodworkers Guild. He was past president of Poseyville Kiwanis and was a 20 year veteran of the Wadesville Fire Department and a member of the VFW and DAV and the Wadesville Christian Church.

Surviving are his wife: Florence (Lewis) Kincheloe and sons: Gary (Robbie) Kincheloe and Allen (Donna) Kincheloe and a step grandson: William McCutchan all of Evansville, Indiana.

Preceding him in death were his parents and a sister: Blanche Payne.

Wadesville Christian Church in Wadesville, Indiana with burial in Laurel Hill Cemetery.
